Ask your own questions in the course evaluation

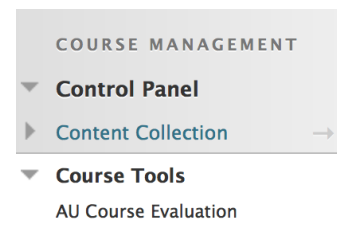
The recent upgrade of the course evaluation module provides the possibility of asking your own questions in the general course evaluation.

You can still select questions from the common question pool, but also create your own reusable question pool.

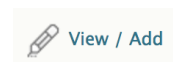
How to

1. Find your course page.

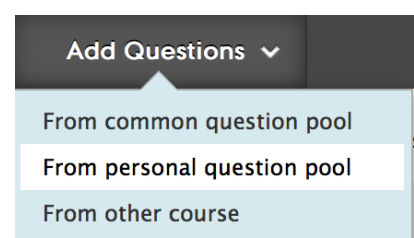
Click on *Course Tools* in the Course Management menu and select *AU Course Evaluation*.



2. Click the *View/Add* icon next to the evaluation.



3. Click *Add Questions* and select *From personal question pool*.



4. Click *Create question*.

5. Fill in the information of the question you wish to ask and click *Create*.

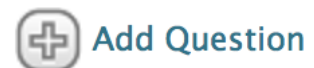
